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1. Introduction

Online applications are invited from the intending male candidates through the website www.lokaseba-odisha.in to fill up 521 posts of Constables in 9th India Reserve Battalion (Specialised) of Odisha Police.

Those applicants who are facing difficulties while applying online due to networking connectivity problems, may approach the Help Desk of State Selection Board, or the Help Desk at the Battalions/office of the Supdt. of Police, Kalahandi whose locations are provided in the Col-18.6 for necessary assistance.

Manual application Forms will be available on payment of Rs.50/-(Rupees fifty) only in shape of Bank Draft in favour of Chairman, State Selection Board, Odisha Police, Cuttack, (Payable at Cuttack). **The manual Application Forms from outside or any other sources will not be entertained.**

The Reception Counter for selling of manual Application Forms will remain open from **10 AM to 5PM on working days only, at the Battalion Headquarters as well as office of the Superintendent of Police, Kalahandi as listed in Col 18.6.**

Where applicants want to submit the filled in manual Application Forms, they should do so along with requisite amount as mentioned in para 18.5 and other required documents at Camp Office of State Selection Board functioning at OSAP 6th Bn., OMP Square, Cuttack in person (**not by any other means**) and receive the acknowledgement of the receipt of the Application Form, on or before the last day and time for applying. The filled in manual Application Form will be received from **10 AM to 5PM on working days only.**

Communication will be made to the applicants through SMS / email provided by the applicants in their Application Forms. The applicants have to download e-pass for physical measurement test, for physical efficiency test and for written examination and other important information from time to time from the website.

Applicants are cautioned against applying more than once for the same post in the same recruitment test.

Applicants are suggested to apply online, in time, in order to avoid last minutes rush.

Besides, the reservation for Ex-Servicemen/Sports persons shall be made in accordance with provisions made under such Act, Rules, Orders or Instructions as issued by the Government from time to time.

30% of the vacancies shall be filled up by recruits hailing from districts notified as Extremist/Left Wing Extremist affected: provided that the Government may fill up the posts under the provisions of Orissa Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules,1990.

The physical measurement and physical efficiency test will be held in the aforesaid location with effect from 16.01.2017 at 7.00 a.m. The candidates will be informed the exact date and time for their physical measurement test through SMS and e-Mail. The aforesaid examination may continue for a long period. Hence, the candidates are required to come prepared to stay for a few days. **ePass for appearing for above test should be downloaded from website www.lokaseba-odisha.in using login id and password provided to applicant while applying for this post.** Exact date and time for appearing at the venue for various events shall be notified in the e-Pass issued thrice during the recruitment process i.e. 1st e-Pass for Physical Measurement Test, 2nd e-Pass for Physical Efficiency Test after he qualifies in Height, Weight & Chest, 3rd e-Pass will be issued for appearing in the Written Test provided that the candidate qualifies all events of Physical Efficiency Test. **At any point of time the candidate disqualifies, he shall not proceed to the next stage.**

3. Terms and Conditions of Service

The appointment to the posts shall be made initially on contractual basis on consolidated monthly remuneration. The conditions of service and the tenure of the contractual appointment to the posts will be regulated by the Odisha Group-C and Group-D posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules, 2013.

4. Examination Fees

All applicants other than SC, ST category have to pay online Examination Fees of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) between 05.12.2016 to 02.01.2017 The fee can be deposited through online mode by logging into the website www.lokaseba-odisha.in through Debit Card, Credit Card, Net

Banking, cash/cheque payment through challan at all SBI Branches or at Common Service Centers(CSCs) of the district through CSC Wallet. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. The detailed instructions for online payment of examination fee have been explained under Para-18.3. Similarly, payment of examination fee for the candidates who want to submit application form manually has been explained under para-18.5.

5. Registration of Name in Employment Exchange

A candidate should have registered his name in any one of the Employment Exchanges of the State before the publication of advertisement for recruitment of Constables in 9th India Reserve Battalion (Specialised). A candidate should not register his name in more than one Employment Exchange.

6. Age limit

The age of the candidates should not be less than 18 years or more than 23 years as on 01.01.2016 (relaxation in maximum age in case of SC, ST & SEBC candidates is up to 5 years). The age limit for Ex-Servicemen shall be relaxed as per Govt. Rules. **The candidates shall avail only one benefit as indicated above.**

7. Qualification

Candidate must have passed High School Certificate examination or equivalent examination conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha or by any other recognized Board / Council. A candidate should be able to speak, read and write Odia and must have passed Odia as one of the subjects in the High School Certificate Examination or an examination in Odia Language equivalent to M.E standard recognized or conducted by the School and Mass Education Department of Government of Odisha.

8. Other eligibility criteria

- a. A candidate must be of good character.
- b. If married, the candidate must not have more than one spouse living.
- c. A candidate must be of sound health and free from organic defect and physical deformity.

N.B. :- The candidates are required to produce original certificates of his educational qualification for verification by the Board at any time during the recruitment process. If any candidate fails to produce the required certificates, he shall be disqualified and the candidate shall not be allowed to participate in the further recruitment process. Besides, if the Board feels that the candidate does not possess the requisite qualification for the post of Constable at that time the candidature shall be disqualified. (ii) The Sports person who participated in Open National Championship and international competitive sports event and the same should be sponsored either by the recognized National Sports Federation / Associations or Indian Olympic Associations or Odisha State Sports Association affiliated with recognized National Sports Federations / Associations and the sports person as a person who would have been issued Identity Card as "Sports Person", by the Director, Sports. Only such sports persons who is deficient in physical standard of measurement by 3 cm in height, 2 cm in chest, and 5 kg in weight shall be relaxed as per Rule.

(iii) The candidates having physical disability or deformity are not eligible for participating in the aforesaid Recruitment of Constables in 9th India Reserve Battalion (Specialized).

11. Physical Measurement and Physical Efficiency Test

Physical Measurement / Physical Efficiency Test and written examination will be conducted for selection of candidates. For that process the candidates are required to come prepare to stay for few days. Technology may be utilized during physical efficiency test. Before or after physical measurement the Battalion Level Selection Board shall form a committee to examine the physical deformity of the candidates and for the purpose, the decision of the committee will be final. The candidates will be informed through SMS/mail about the dates, time and place of such tests.

11.1 Physical measurement (Height) - 3 Bonus Marks

Candidates with height 178 cms or above irrespective of categories shall be awarded 3 bonus marks.

12. Driving Test: - Allotted Marks: 05

The test shall be conducted only for those candidates, who claim in their applications that they are proficient in driving and possess either Light or Heavy Vehicle Driving license for the last one year (excluding learning period) or more from the date of advertisement of vacancies.

(i) Those candidates who possess Heavy Vehicle Driving License and pass Heavy Vehicle Driving test, shall be awarded 05 marks.

(ii) Those candidates who have the Light Vehicle Driving License and pass Light Vehicle Driving test, shall be awarded 3 marks, of those appearing for the test and awarded the marks shall be deemed to have accepted the service condition that if called upon, they shall have to drive the Light or Heavy vehicle, as the case may be, as part of their normal duties and responsibilities. Driving test shall not be conducted without verification of validity of the Vehicle Driving License and the date of its issue.

- Written test shall consist of multiple choice questions in Oriya Language, English Language, Arithmetic, General Knowledge, Aptitude and Logical reasoning etc. The standard of the question shall be such that a student who has passed High School Certificate Examination shall be able to answer.
- The Candidates not appearing for written test shall be disqualified.
- The examination shall be conducted using OMR method.
- Selection Board will decide the minimum qualifying marks in the written test.

17. Medical Examination

A Committee consisting of a Medical Officer not below the rank of SDMO and another Doctor shall conduct medical examination before commencement of the Physical Efficiency Test. The candidates having organic defects, physical deformity or found unfit are not allowed to appear in Physical Efficiency Test.

18. How to apply:

Eligible candidates can apply for this application by visiting at www.lokaseba-odisha.in or at nearby **Common Service Centres (CSC)**. The details of the post advertised and **instructions** for submitting application online shall appear on the computer's screen and are detailed under below. These instructions are to be read carefully before proceeding for filling up the Registration page and Online Application Form. Details of Common Service Centers of the district in Odisha would be available at website only.

18.1 Pre-requisites for Registration and Online Application

- All applicants other than those belonging to SC/ST categories have to make Payment of Rs.200/-(Rupees Two Hundred Only) only towards Examination Fee.
- Full Specimen signature of the applicant, scanned in "jpg" format between the ranges of **10 Kbs to 20 Kbs** shall be kept handy for uploading prior to making Registration for the post.
- Applicants shall keep their Certificates and Mark sheet ready for filling in the details of the educational qualification during Online Application.
- In addition, they shall keep ready recent pass port size photograph, scanned in the "jpg" format between the ranges of **20 Kbs to 50 Kbs** for uploading during the Online Application.
- The photograph and full specimen signature scanned for uploading must be clearly identifiable /visible, otherwise the registration and application shall be liable to rejection and no correspondence on this account shall be entertained.
- Applicants must have their own personal E-mail ID and Mobile Number with validity till the completion of the recruitment process for receiving all important communication like Activation Key, various alerts and downloading Admission Letters and other intended document(s) from the www.lokaseba-odisha.in Under no circumstances, an applicant should share his e-mail ID and Mobile/Cell Number with any other person. In case he does not have a valid e-Mail ID, he shall create a new e-Mail ID for applying Online.
- Applicant would be provided with one username and password to login on website which he should note for all future references. ePass, marks declaration or all details/notice would be available through online only, no separate physical communication would be sent.

- c) Candidate can directly apply through link on Home Page "Apply for Recruitment of Constables in 9th IRB.
- d) Applicant can provide his Aadhar number to fetch basic details from Aadhar database. In case of non availability of Aadhar, applicant can fill the form manually. Applying of Aadhar facility is also available free of cost at all Common Service Center as well.
- e) Applicant shall fill all the mandatory details (Scanned Photo/Signature) in form and click on next to proceed further.
- f) Applicant shall upload the scan copy of all mandatory documents and click on submit. Ensure that, the uploaded document is clearly identifiable / visible; otherwise the registration shall be liable to rejection.
- g) Applicant shall pay fee of Rs.200/- through "Online Payment" using the Debit Card / Net Banking Facilities provided by SBI Bank, at Common Service Center through CSC wallet or offline at SBI branches.
- h) On successful completion of the Online Payment, an acknowledgement receipt will be generated for future reference.

- b) Applicant shall fill the form carefully and attach self attested copies of all mandatory certificates.
- c) Applicant shall submit the filled in application form along with Bank Draft for Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred) only towards the cost of examination fee (except SC/ST categories) in favour of Chairman, State Selection Board, Odisha Police, Cuttack (Payable at Cuttack) at OSAP 6th Battalion, OMP Square Cuttack, **personally** (not by any other means) and shall receive the acknowledgement of the receipt of submitted application form. 19. Place and Date of Exam:

The date/time/venue of the Physical Measurement/Physical Efficiency Test as well as Written Test will be conveyed to the eligible candidates through the e-Pass to be issued online in due course. The eligible candidates shall download the same by accessing the Common Application Portal:- www.lokaseba-odisha.in by using their User ID and Password from a specific date to be notified in the said website later. The list of applicant allowed/disallowed to appear in the test shall be displayed in the website simultaneously from that date. The candidates are advised to visit the website of www.lokaseba-odisha.in at regular intervals and also keep track of different notices to be published by the State Selection Board in different local dailies to know about the program of the Examination/s.

20. e-Pass

e-Pass, containing intimation about the date, time and venue for the Physical Measurement/Physical Efficiency Test/Written Test carrying the scanned photographed and signature of the eligible applicants and specimen signature of the Chairperson of the State Selection Board shall be uploaded on the website i.e. www.lokaseba-odisha.in well ahead of the date of examination. Each eligible applicant shall have to download his admission letter before the date of examination by visiting the aforementioned website and clicking on the submenu "Online e-Pass" .The dates of Examination shall be advertised in the local News Papers for information of the candidates. Further SMS alert will also be sent to the candidates through the mobile/cell phone number mentioned by them in the applications. The State Selection Board will not send any printed e-Pass to any candidate through post.

21. Warning to the Candidates

The recruitment of Constables in 9th India Reserve Battalion (Specialised) will be conducted in a free, fair and transparent manner. The selection of the candidates will be merit based. Therefore, the candidates are warned not to indulge in any malpractice or attempt any unfair means during the recruitment process. They are cautioned against payment of bribe /illegal gratification to middle men/touts for securing job. If any malpractice or corruption come to the notice of State Selection Board, then persons demanding and receiving bribes as well as the concerned candidates will be liable to face criminal prosecution for the offence and their candidature is liable to be cancelled. If any such activities come to notice to any candidate, he should approach to State Vigilance Department in their website: www.odishavigilance.gov.in .

22. Select List & Result

On completion of the recruitment test a Select List will be drawn up of the successful candidates in order of merit, category wise as per the advertisement. The Select List will be prepared in decreasing order of aggregate marks secured by the candidates in accordance with the vacancies in which the total persons shall not exceed the number of vacancies advertised. The final result shall be published in due course in the website www.lokaseba-odisha.in.
