Age limit: The upper age limit will be finalized by the Appointing Authority based on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.

Borooah Cancer Institute, Guwahati” payable at Guwahati.

Persons working under Central / State Govt. / Public Sector Undertakings / Autonomous organization should submit their application through proper channel. The applicant not having the NOC from the concerned institution will not be considered for selection. However, to avoid delay the applicant may send an advance copy of the application along with enclosures which should reach before the prescribed last date. However, the advance copy will only be considered in case the application is received through proper channel..

The candidate for medical faculty posts must be registered with the Medical Council of Indian States / Union Territories.

Preference will be given to the candidate having working experience in the respective fields in recognized institutions.

Limited residential single / family accommodation available inside hospital premises.

Private practice outside hospital working hours is permissible as per existing rules.

The Management of Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute will not be responsible for rejection of applications due to late postal delivery.

The Institute reserves the right to reject or accept any candidature without assigning any reason thereof.

The decision of the Institute as to eligibility or otherwise of a candidate will be final.

The applicants, who do not have requisite qualifications up to the last date for submission of applications, will not be considered.
