National Atmospheric Research Laboratory (NARL) is a centre of excellence involved in doing front ranking research in atmospheric and space sciences and development of related technologies. NARL desires to recruit a Junior Research Fellow to work on the project " Temporal and spatial characterization of the Martian thermosphere, ionosphere, and exosphere (TIE) system". The project involves processing and analysis of data from the Mars upper atmosphere obtained by the Mars Orbiter Mission (MOM) and the Mars Atmosphere and Volatile EvolutioN (MAVEN) spacecraft.

- The position is temporary and renewable each year subject to satisfactory performance for a maximum of three years. Candidate selected for this position may also apply for the regular PhD program in any of the universities in India.
- 1. **Age limit**: Less than 30 years on the last date fixed for receipt of applications but relaxation for five years in the case of SC/ST candidates and three years for OBC candidates. Ex-servicemen and persons with disabilities (PWD) are eligible for age relaxation as per government of India orders.
- 2. **Selection Process:** Mere fulfilment of essential qualifications and experience do not vest any right in a candidate for being called for Test/Interview. A duly constituted screening committee shall screen the applications received for the post. The Laboratory reserves the right to call for Interview only those candidates who in its opinion are likely to be suitable and will not entertain any correspondence in this regard.
- 3. The Candidates who are already employed under Central /State Government, Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Organizations should send their printed on-line application invariably followed-up with a **NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE** from the employer concerned.
- 4. SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Ex-servicemen candidates are required to produce a copy of the certificate in the prescribed format signed by the specified Authority at the time of interview. A person who wants to avail of benefit of PWD reservation would have to submit a disability certificate issued by a Competent Authority in the prescribed format. Degree of disability for reservation : only such person would be eligible for reservation in services / posts who suffer from not less than 40% of relevant disability.
- 5. The date of determining the eligibility of all candidates in every respect shall be the last date fixed for receipt of applications.
- 6. The decision of NARL in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of applications, mode of selection, conduct of interview, will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained in this connection from any individual or agency on behalf of the candidate.

7. HOW TO APPLY :

- a) Applications should be submitted as per the prescribed format. Candidates should enclose attested true copies of the relevant certificates/ testimonials, Mark-lists as proof of age, educational qualification, caste, experience etc., along with the application.
- b) Incomplete applications received without the requisite information asked for in the prescribed format/without signature/without photograph pasted at the appropriate place/without attested true copies of all the certificates in support of their claim for educational qualifications, experience, age, caste etc., will summarily rejected out-right.
- c) Candidates should specifically note that the applications received after the closing date for any reason whatsoever (such as envelopes wrongly addressed, delivered elsewhere, postal delay etc.) will not be entertained by this Laboratory. Any enclosure received separately subsequent to the receipt of the application cannot be connected therewith. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- d) Applications duly completed in all respects along with its enclosures should reach THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, NATIONAL ATMOSPHERIC RESEARCH LABORATORY, P.B. NO.123, P.O. 8. OTHER CONDITIONS / INSTRUCTIONS :

- a) Candidates attending the interview will be reimbursed **AC 3 Tier Class** train fare by the shortest route to the place of interview from the Railway Station nearest to the normal place of residence of the candidate or from which he/she actually performs the journey, whichever, is nearer to the place of interview, and back to the same station or the amount of Railway fare actually incurred by the candidate whichever is less.
- b) The number of posts indicated above are provisional and may vary depending on the actual requirements of the Organisation.
- c) Candidates called for interview will have to produce all relevant original documents in proof of details furnished in their applications submitted on-line, at the time of interview. If any information furnished on-line is found to be wrong or false, the candidate will not be interviewed and TA will not be paid.
- d) NARL reserves the right not to fill up all or any of the posts, if it so desires.
- e) Only Indian nationals need apply.
- f) No interim correspondence will be entertained.
- g) Canvassing in any form will disqualify a candidate.
