1. Controller of Examinations: 1 (One) Post (Unreserved).

Pay Band: ₹37,400 – 67,000/- + Academic Grade Pay ₹10,000/- and other allowances as admissible.

Essential Qualifications:

- (i) Uniformly good academic record with a Master's degree with minimum 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale where a grading system is followed.
- (ii) At least 15 years' experience as Sr. Lecturer / Reader / Assistant Professor in the AGP of ₹. 7,000/- and above or with 8 years' of service in the AGP of ₹. 8,000/- and above including as Associate Professor along with experience in educational administration in Academic Institution like University, or an institute of higher learning of which 5(five) years must be in a University or in an Institute of Post Graduate Study.

or

- (iii) Comparable experience in research establishments and other institutions of higher learning,
- (iv) 15(fifteen) years' administrative experience, of which 8(eight) years shall be as Deputy Registrar or equivalent post.
- (v) Age not less than 40 years. Relaxable in the case of exceptionally qualified candidate.

Desirable Qualification:

(i) A Doctorate degree or published research work of merit

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- (ii) High level administrative experience in government / quasi-government organization or a good background in administration and management in a senior position.

- d. However, the candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the Minimum Eligibility Condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- e. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters programme in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
- f. A relaxation of 5% in the marks may be provided for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/Differently abled (physically as well as visually) categories
 - (i) at the Masters level required to satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria.
 - (ii) for assessing good academic record throughout the candidate's career.
 - The marks in each case mean the qualifying marks without any grace marks and/or rounding off procedures.
- g. A relaxation of 5% may be provided for the minimum eligibility marks of 55% at the Master level to the Ph.D. degree holders who have obtained their Masters degree prior to September 19, 1991
- h. Maximum age will be determined by the University authority.

- 5. In case of contractual posts, the appointment will be made initially for a period of 1(One) year. Based on the performance, contract may be renewed for a further period.
- 6. Persons employed in Government / Semi Government Organizations / Autonomous Bodies should submit their application through proper channel. They may, however, send an advance copy of the application. Those who are unable to process their application through proper channel may submit 'No Objection Certificate (NOC)' from present employer during the time of interview. However, they should submit an undertaking to that effect. Direct application from such candidates will not be entertained.
